

CHARTER ROUNDTABLE EVALUATION



Methodology: This is a summary of feedback from young people and attendees who completed an evaluation form after the Roundtable event. 45 people attended the event with 23 providing feedback. 16 young people contributed to the Roundtable with 9 providing feedback.

Roundtable Aims: To launch the Rights Charter to a wide range of partner organisations; to demonstrate best practice in participation; to provide leadership opportunities for the young people and give them a positive experience in sharing their work and views.



100% of young people strongly agreed or agreed that developing the charter and participating in the Roundtable event improved their team working skills

100% of young people strongly agreed or agreed that what they said during meetings was seen as important.

100% of young people strongly agreed or agreed that taking part in the Roundtable improved their confidence.

100% of young people strongly agreed or agreed that they felt valued and respected throughout

100% of attendees said the balance between presentations, discussions and interactive elements was very well balanced or well balanced

95.5% of attendees said that the Roundtable either exceeded their expectations or met their expectations

100% of attendees said that the charter was very comprehensive or comprehensive in addressing forces children's rights

95.5% of attendees said that the Roundtable had either a significant, moderate or slight impact on their understanding of forces children's rights

PARTICIPATION PRACTICE



Listen to what young people's thoughts and views are rather than asking them what we want to hear.

I have gained confidence and the ability to speak in front of people that I don't know.

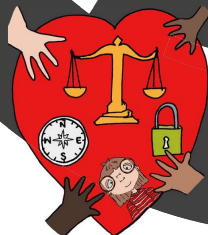
My ability to make new friends easier and take part in fun activities
